

Larry Grosenbach called meeting to order.

Pastor Alex led opening prayer.

April 2024 minutes were reviewed. Motion to approve by Jerry K., seconded by Arnie W. Motion carried.

Treasurer's report: Motion to approve by Arnie W., seconded by Jyll J. Motion carried.

<u>Christian Education</u>: Sunday School ended for summer months. Shelly G. working on VBS. Children are getting more and more involved in morning worship.

Evangelism: Dinelle F. sent some children's birthday cards out.

<u>History</u>: Jerry discussed beginning to plan for Zion's 175th anniversary in 2027. Also, church history needs to be updated. Bill Johnson reported to Jerry that there are tombstones at Peru City Cemetery on graves that are historically significant to Zion Church. Bill suggested that we get pictures of them because they are becoming weathered and difficult to read.

<u>Missions</u>: May will be last PADS meal this season. We will continue to provide meals again in fall when the shelter reopens. IV Food Pantry applied and is under consideration for a \$750,000 grant through Community Project Funding.

<u>Building and Grounds</u>: Jerry is working on new signs for church entrance doors/ handicap signs. 'Raise the Roof' campaign is going well. \$9500 has been raised of the 17,000 required. Installation will be done in late May or early June. Jerry spoke with Scott Rohr from OSF regarding our parking lot. Scott understands that OSF employees and patients are using our lot and will continue to do so. OSF has agreed to maintain the lot in return for use of it. A written agreement will be drawn up. Jerry and Scott will meet to finalize the deal.



Worked at the Ladies Tea as server, cleanup, etc. We celebrated moms and mom figures on Mother's Day by presenting the ladies with a carnation. Pentecost and Music Sunday was a success. I'll be meeting with Kathy Lawes soon regarding ordination preparation. Still preparing for VBS 2024! Rev. Kathy Lawes, our Association Minister, was with us on April 21. She led the entire service, allowing me the opportunity to sit with my family and enjoy the service. Kathy stayed for coffee hour then went to lunch with a group of us. It was a great day. Friday May 24 I'll be at HyVee working the Feed the Children Food Drive for the Food Pantry. Worship and lunch at Pilgrim Park is May 26. Summer is upon us. Enjoy! 
